

# ScottAgri iPad App Instructions

## Installing the ScottAgri iPad App

Go to the App Store. Search for 'ScottAgri', select the iPad version of the app, and install.

### Before Using App


The first time you run the app, you will see an alert telling you that "Settings Not Set".

This means that you haven't entered your client credentials. If you see this message:

Tap the "OK" button to dismiss the alert message.

Tap the "Close" menu item, to close the app.

Enter your user credentials and restart the app.




### Setting User Credentials

Open the iPad Settings app. Locate then select "ScottAgri iPad" under Apps.

Enter your client ID, user name, and password.

You can get this information by calling the Scott Agri office

Exit the Settings app. You are now ready to run the ScottAgri app



# ScottAgri iPad App Instructions

## Using the App


Run the app by finding and pressing the ScottAgri iPad icon on your phone:



When first run, the ScottAgri app displays the menu bar on the left side of the screen, and your 'IPL/YBL' information on the right side of the screen.

You can change the information that is displayed on the right side of the screen by selecting different options from the menu bar.

The IPL/YBL screen displays your current IPL (Important Price Level) and YBL (Your Bottom Line) values for the current and next crop seasons



The menu items are:

**IPL** – displays the IPL screen.

**Sales** – displays a list of crops that you have sales for. You can select a crop from the list to display detailed sales information for that crop.

**Open Positions** – displays your current market positions

**Report a Sale** – allows you to report a cash sale via phone or email.

**Close** – exit the app.


Note that you can scroll the details (right side of the screen) up/down and left/right to display all the available data, as well as pinch to zoom/shrink the display.

## Sales


Selecting the “Sales” menu item, displays a list of crops that you have reported sales for.

Tap on a crop to display detailed information about sales for that particular crop.



Here is a sample of a Sales page.

Pressing the “Sales” menu item will re-display the crop list.

## Market Positions

Selecting the “Open Positions” button, displays a list of your current market positions.

Your market positions are grouped as:

- Short Futures
- Long Calls
- Long Futures
- Long Puts
- Short Options



## Reporting Sales


The "Report a Sale" menu item allows you to report a cash sale to ScottAgri

When you select this option, you will be presented with this form. Fill in as much information as possible about your sale on this form.



For the Cax Month, and Crop fields, you can either type in the information, or you can tap the blue symbol to the right of the field and to be presented with a list of items to choose from

Simply tap the desired item in the list to selected it.

After entering all the information into the form, press the "Send Email" button at the bottom of the screen.
